Gift Aid

Thank you to all those who have signed up for gift aid to allow the parish to claim a tax rebate on donations received. From January to June the parish has managed to receive £31,851.70 from HMRC which includes a retrospective claim for monies not previously received over recent years. However it could be more. May I ask those who pay by contactless to please enter in your details if you are a tax payer. You will only have to do this once and your details will not be used for any other purpose other than claiming Gift Aid. Once you submit your details, all future donation made on the same card will automatically qualify for Gift Aid.
